This is a 100-point car, complete rotisserie frame-off restoration completed in February of this year.

- The car is finished in Dupont chroma base 2-stage paint, black over Wimbledon white with new interior, black with ivory trim.
- The engine, transmission, and overdrive were completely rebuilt, using new or new old stock mechanical parts, to new or better than new standards.
- Exhaust manifolds have been jet coated and attached to a new stainless steel muffler system.
- Additional rebuilds include, carburetors, starter, and generator.
- New brake and clutch Master cylinders have been installed along with new metal lines.

- All new cloth wiring harness has been installed along with new or rebuilt electrical components.
- Original steering wheel has been refurbished.
- Gauges have been rebuilt and recalibrated.
- Finish work on car has been rechrome or purchased new and the fittings for both the trunk and bonnet have been chrome plated or nicked.
- All hardware used on this car has been cad plated grade 8 or better.
- Car is fitted with new Robbins Everflex top, tonneau cover, and side curtains.
- New Dunlop wire wheels with correct size tires and spare finish off the car.
